KEY THOUGHT

A biblical miracle happens when there is a need sensed by a group of people, led by God, to respond in faith.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where are you in the process right now: surrendering to God, hearing His voice, obeying what He says, or believing God to do a miracle through you?
2. Which step in the process is the most difficult or scary?
3. Why do you think God invites us to participate in His miracle process? Why not just do it all Himself?
4. What do you think God may be teaching you through this process?
5. Do we sometimes resist stepping out and participating with God? Why is that?
6. 2 Corinthians 9:10 says that God “supplies seed to the sower.” What does this mean to you? How does it impact your level of generosity?
7. There are three levels of giving: (1) What can I afford? (2) What can I sacrifice? (3) What can God do through me? Discuss the difference between these levels.
8. Have you ever given something beyond what you could afford? If so, what happened as a result?

APPLICATION QUESTION

In what area of your life do you need a miracle? (Examples: your health, marriage, finances, job, child, etc.)
